

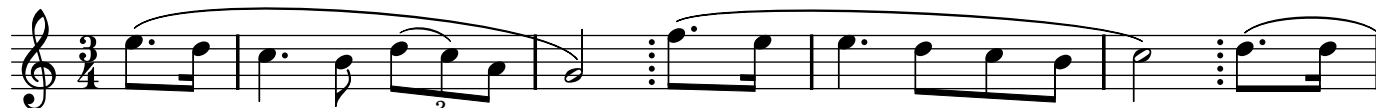
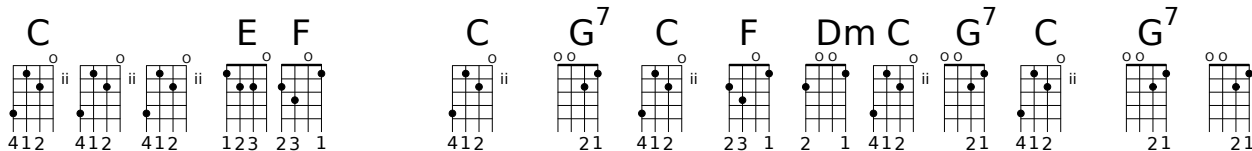

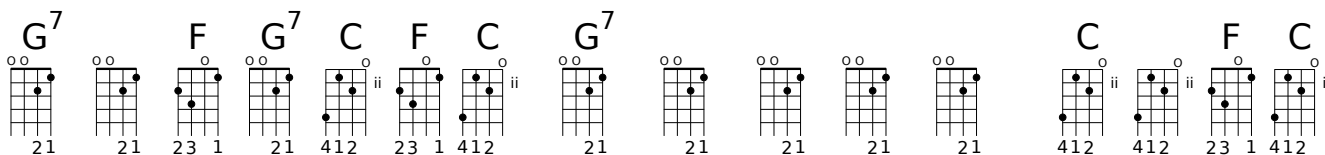

and the peace-ful rest, Then, while lean - ing on Thy breast,

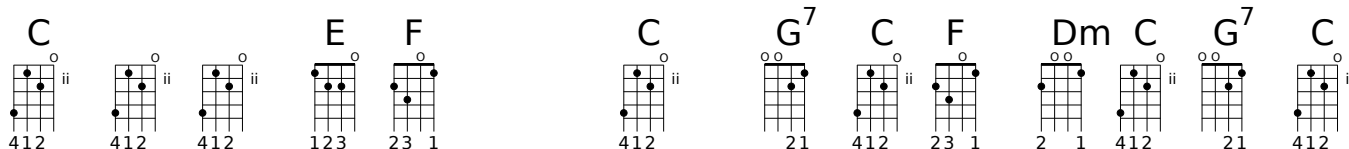


Chart and com - pass came from Thee: Je - sus Sav - iour, pi - lot me.
