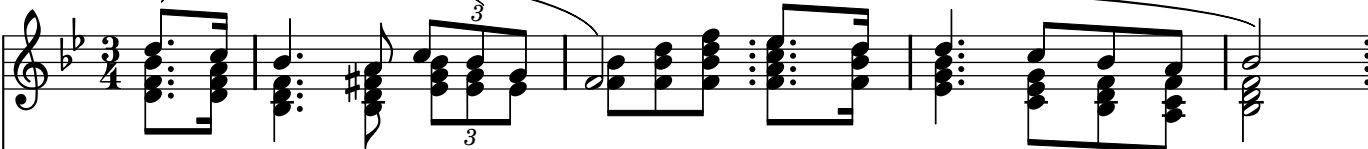

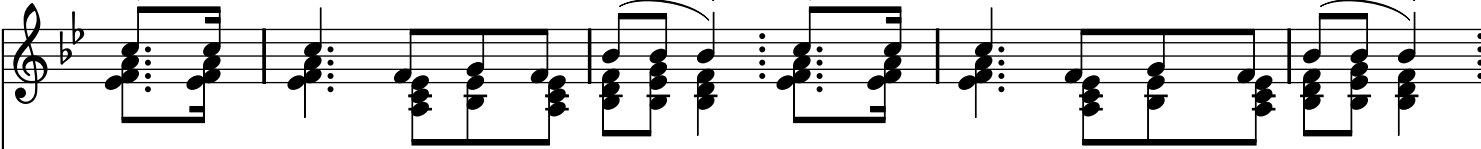

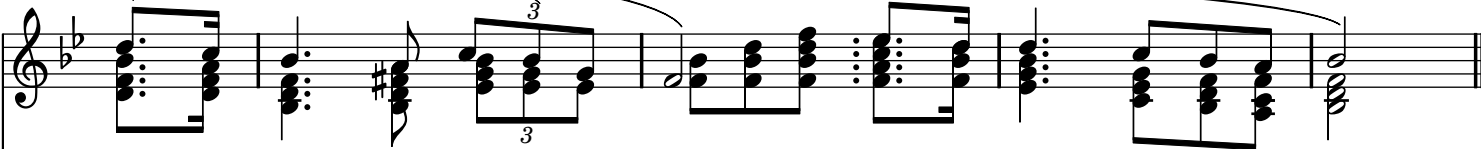


Chart and com - pass came from Thee: Je - sus Sav - iour, pi - lot me.
